

Counseling Services

Under no circumstances can any employee with Positive Directions II LLC provide counseling services to a child whose parents are pursuing the courts in a custody situation. This applies to all of the programs with Positive Directions II LLC who provide counseling services.

As it relates to services, counseling, cannot not take place unless “BOTH” parents have signed the appropriate form and authorized counseling services if both parents have custody. If one parent agrees that counseling would help their child and the other parent disagrees, you as the counselor or helping professional cannot provide counseling services to the child.

If a parent has sole or total custody, he or she can authorize counseling service for their child by the counselor.
